

Marie-Ange Biography by Actionnel Fleurisma Pastor & School Headmaster, Bayonnais, Haiti



Marie-Ange was born to a dysfunctional family on January 10, 1989.

She has been dealing with sour moments ever since. Her mother and father never lived together as parents or as mother and father. In early 2003, her father, Saint-Ange, died from Tuberculosis (TB) at a very young age. In 2007 her mother, Isabelle Donatien, died from TB as well. We had her funeral at the Christian Church of Bayonnais.

Knowing that most of her relatives had passed away years ago, Marie-Ange was in a huge need for some love, care, tenderness and understanding. Such love would provide her some hope for a bright future. So right after the death of her mother, the Fleurisma's felt led to provide a home and a loving family for Marie-Ange.

In April, 2007, we brought her into our home and sent her to school where our biological kids were going. She appeared as healthy as she could be.

We took her to the doctor soon after her arrival in our home. He made a general check up on her and everything looked perfect. Yet, in mid-July, Marie-Ange was declared terribly sick with big cough, high fever and weight loss. We made several trips to doctors until they discovered by an X-Ray that her right lung had already been destroyed from TB. Compare the first two pictures with the one from the hospital and see her weight loss.



Truly it appeared to us that we were going to lose our daughter. Since the 9th of August she has been kept away from her friends, mom and dad (Actionnel & Yolande the adopted parents). She will be staying at the Ennery Medical Center for 2 months if everything goes well.



She always cares for her education and she is very active in the choir at the church. Away from her home because of her illness, her name is still among the ones that made it to the 13th grade from the 12th grade national exam. She surely is a very bright person.

Please pray for us and for Marie-Ange. Our hope and prayers is for God to use her like he did for Esther. I have told Marie-Ange that "your dad was at Ennery for treatment for 5 months but he died. Her mother was also there for treatment, but she also died. Now you are here for the same reason BUT YOU ARE NOT GOING TO DIE! You will go home healthy."

Pray for Bayonnais that has become a household for TB with many people suffering from this disease. Pray for God's plan to come to pass into Marie-Ange's life. Just as plants grow, Marie-Ange will grow as well and she will have a testimony.
