#### **Explanation and Additional Information:**

Doctor's salary was based upon average Haitian doctor's salary at a private clinic of \$8,000 HD a month minus the price of education spread out over a 15 year span, which is the length of his/her contract. The nurse and lab technicians' salaries are also based on the average Haitian salary for these jobs. However, the cost of their education in conjunction with the length of their contracts (10 years) makes it difficult for OFCB to recoup the monetary investment in each individual's education. The cost of medicine will take up the largest part of the clinic's budget and could easily top \$85,000 USD a year.
